Programs

HSI offers three programs of study to meet the needs of beginning, professional and advanced students of homeopathy. Locally, nationally and internationally renowned instructors, including some of the greatest names in modern homeopathy, provide quality education for all programs.

1. Foundations of Homeopathy for Home Care (125 hours)

Interested in exploring homeopathy to improve health care for you and your family? This course addresses first aid and acute health conditions typically encountered in every day life, including: bruises and injuries, bites and stings, sunburns, gastric upsets, breast feeding, teething, fevers, colds, flues, and earaches. This course will give you the skills to meet those personal needs.

- Completion of the course provides participants with materials and skills for personal and family health care.
- Like “being there” students engage in actual classroom activities by viewing the full course content on high quality DVDs.
- Study is self-paced and can begin at any time, from any location.
- Study at your own pace. Participants may take up to one year to complete the course.
- Certified homeopaths support all assignments and casework. Academic support is only a phone call or email away.
- Continue your studies at a professional level, *HSI 101 – Foundation of Homeopathy for Home Care*, completes the first course in the *Practitioner Certificate Program*.
- Tuition: \$2,500 + books, estimated at \$600.

Programs cont.

I. Practitioner Certificate Program (500 hours)

The *HSI Practitioner Certificate Program* provides 500 hours of study in classical homeopathy. Three options of study are available. Instructors, course content and materials are the same for all three options. Graduates of the program qualify to enter the profession as independent practitioners of classical homeopathy. The *Practitioner Certificate Program* is for those seeking a career in the field of alternative health or for healthcare professionals seeking to expand their expertise by including homeopathic treatment.

A. Self-Paced Practitioner Certificate

DVD Distance Education option – Available worldwide

- Offered in four courses (HSI 101, HSI 102, HSI 201, HSI 202), each course contains study guides, course materials, assignments and 90 hours of digitally recorded DVD instruction.
- Completion of all four courses provides the participant with professional certification.
- Like “being there” students engage in actual classroom activities by viewing full course content and clinics on high quality DVDs.
- Certified homeopaths support student assignments and casework. Academic support is only a phone call or email away.
- Provides flexibility for completing the program at an accelerated or slower pace.
- Study can begin at any time, from any location worldwide. Take up to one year to complete each course
- Tuition: \$2,500 per course. The cost of books is estimated at \$800. Total tuition for the program is \$10,000 + books.

Programs cont.

B. DVD Distance Education- Available to Canadian and US students

- Offered in 20 modules over two years, each module includes 18 hours of digitally recorded DVD instruction, study guides, course materials, and assignments.
- Completion of all 20 modules provides the participant with professional certification.
- Like “being there” students engage in actual classroom activities through high quality DVDs.
- Certified homeopaths support student assignments and casework. Academic advice is only a phone call or an email away.
- Study begins in September. One module is completed per month.
- Tuition is \$8,400 + books (estimated at \$800.00). Payment plans are available.

C. Two-year Resident Program - Available to local students

- Offered in 20 weekends over two years (September – June), each weekend of study contains 18 hours of instruction.
- Completion of all 20 weekends provides participants with professional certification.
- Meets at the Boulder, Colorado classroom one weekend per month (Sept-June) for a total of twenty sessions during the two-year program.
- Certified homeopaths support all students with assignments and casework. Academic advice is only a phone call or an email away.
- Students attending class in person interact and network with fellow-students.
- Tuition is \$8,400 + books (estimated at \$800.00). Payments plans are available.

III. Advanced Clinical Studies (280 hours)

Advanced Clinical Studies is a distance education program for graduates of a 500-hour program in classical homeopathy. The program offers advanced study with case supervision and 250 hours of clinical training required for national certification with the Council for Homeopathic Certification (CHC). Tuition is \$2,500 + books, estimated at \$200. Participants have a maximum of two years to complete personal supervised casework. Payment options are available.

Who May Apply

I. Foundations of Homeopathy for Home Care

Open to anyone interested in learning about homeopathic care for personal and family needs.

II. Practitioner Certificate Program

Open to qualified individuals interested in developing professional-level skills in classical homeopathy and to individuals who have successfully completed *HSI 101*.

III. Advanced Clinical Studies

Open to graduates of a 500-hour program in classical homeopathy.

COURSE CONTENT

I. Foundations in Homeopathy Home Care - HSI 101 (125 hours)

Students study the concepts and methods of homeopathy, first aid and acute treatment, develop efficiency in using reference tools, explore homeopathic case taking skills, and the application of commonly used homeopathic remedies. Completion of this course equips participants with personal and family homeopathic healthcare skills. Successful completion of *HSI 101* can be applied as the entry course to the *Practitioner Certificate Program*.

II. Professional Practitioner Certificate Programs (500 hours)

1st year - Two-Year Option and HSI 101 and 102 Self-paced Option (250 hours)

During the first year of the program, students

- Study the history, theory and techniques of homeopathy: first aid, acute and chronic treatment
- Develop efficiency in using reference tools
- Apply homeopathic case taking skills
- Study case analysis methods
- Explore the application of specific homeopathic remedies.
- Apply learning to video recorded and student-generated cases.

2nd year - Two-Year Option and HSI 201 and 202 Self-paced Option (250 hours)

During the second year of the program, students

- Participate in the school's clinic
- Learn from clinical observation and casework supported by advanced homeopathic therapy
- Engage in independent supervised case studies
- Increase their understanding of homeopathic remedies for professional use
- Graduate with a *Professional Practitioner Certificate*

STUDY TIME

A minimum of 10 hours of study time per week is estimated to successfully complete each program.

III. Advanced Clinical Studies Program (280 hours)

During advanced clinical studies, the program provides:

- Individual case supervision for 10 cases and 20 follow-ups
- Case observation and supervision for school clinic cases (delivered on digitally recorded DVDs)
- Online case work
- Review of CHC required remedies for the national exam with practice tests
- Systems, pathology and medical terminology review and practice tests
- Repertory review and practice tests

CERTIFICATION

I. Foundations in Homeopathy Home Care - HSI 101

Completion documentation is issued when all requirements for *Foundations in Homeopathy Home Care* (HSI 101) are met.

II. Professional Practitioner Certificate Programs

A *Certificate of Classical Homeopathy* (CHom) is issued when all requirements for the *Professional Practitioner Certificate Program* are completed. Graduates of *HSI* may use the designation, CHom, after their name signifying their certification in classical homeopathy. Certification from *HSI* stands for the achievement of a professional level of competency in the art and science of homeopathy. As a certified homeopath, the practitioner may work with individuals interested in experiencing the health promoting benefits of homeopathy.

III. Advanced Clinical Studies Program

Successful participants in the *Advanced Clinical Studies Program* receive a *Certificate in Supervised Clinical Training*. The certificate is earned when all requirements for the program and the total clinical hours required for national certification have been met.

- Photocopy of a college transcript, professional license or documentation of other educational/professional experience.

III. Advanced Clinical Studies Program

Application requirements:

- Completed application form for the *Advanced Clinical Studies Program* – www.homeopathyschool.org
- Photocopy of transcript indicating completion of a 500-hour program in classical homeopathy.
- Non-refundable registration fee of \$75 payable to the *Homeopathy School International*.

ENROLLMENT

Upon receipt of a signed enrollment agreement and the tuition/deposit the school guarantees enrollment in the program.

I. Foundations in Homeopathy Home Care - HSI 101

Accepted applicants receive a *Letter of Acceptance*, an *Enrollment Agreement*, and the school catalog. Individuals planning to enroll return the completed *Enrollment Agreement* with the tuition payment payable to the *Homeopathy School International*. Full tuition for the course and a one-time \$200 DVD deposit are due before materials are mailed.

II. Professional Practitioner Certificate Programs

A. Two-year Practitioner Certificate Options (resident and distance education)

Accepted applicants receive a *Letter of Acceptance*, an *Enrollment Agreement*, a class schedule, and the school catalog. Individuals planning to enroll return the completed *Enrollment Agreement* with an \$800 tuition deposit payable to the *Homeopathy School International*.

B. Self-paced Practitioner Certificate Option

Accepted applicants receive a *Letter of Acceptance*, an *Enrollment Agreement*, and the school catalog. Accepted applicants return the completed *Enrollment Agreement*, a \$2,500 tuition payment per course and a one-time \$200 DVD deposit. Tuition is due before course materials are mailed.

III. Advanced Clinical Studies Program

Accepted applicants receive a *Letter of Acceptance*, an *Enrollment Agreement*, and a school catalog. Individuals planning to enroll return the completed *Enrollment Agreement* with an \$800 tuition deposit payable to the *Homeopathy School International*.
